CSC ALUMS TO SPEAK ON UGANDA

CSC alums Amy Finnegan & Mike Westerhaus will speak as part of a presentation on the "Invisible Children Program" this Thurs., 4/21 at 8:30 p.m. in Friedman Lounge in the Wohl Center.

Amy and Mike will speak to their experiences in Uganda, and the plight of the people who have been tormented by the Lords Resistance Army for 18 years. They will speak about the history of the war, its effects, how the international community has or has not been involved, things they have learned in their research, and how we can help.

The presentation will also include a short documentary of observations from Northern Uganda, an opportunity to write letters to congressmen about the issue, and a benefit concern by the Wash U a-capella group, Mosaic Whispers.
